*We are aware of information circulated this morning indicating that there may be additional road closures this afternoon. However, after speaking with the Superintendent for South Belfast, the PSNI has made it clear that there is no intelligence to suggest this is a credible threat. Schools should remain open, and it is business as usual.*

*We understand that parents are rightly anxious, and therefore, if you feel that you would like to collect your child early today, you are welcome to do so. Otherwise, school will finish at the usual times.*
